History of North Denver By: Immanuel Johnson

On this issue's first edition of the "History of North Denver" we have Elitch Gardens a place that many go to have fun. Many people don't know that Elitch's was originally built as a zoo on May 1,1890 which was the first zoo in America west of Chicago. This gave many people living people in Denver a unique chance to see exotic animals.

In 1904 Elitches opened their first roller coaster which was a simple figure 8 and in 1906 they built their carousel which is still in operation to this day in Burlington.

In 1916 Elitch's was bought by John Mulvihill with the agreement that the name could never be changed as rides began to be added in 1930 the zoo portion of the park was discontinued to make room for gardens and more rides. In 1930 Mulvihill died and gave control to his son in law, Arnold Gulter who in 1935 would give control to his sons.

In 1950 Elitches became the largest supplier of flowers in the country. In 1964 a roller coaster called "Mister Twister" was added which was rated as one of the top ten roller coasters in America until it stopped service in 1994 when Elitches moved to the new location where "Mister Twister 2" was built

Then in 2006 Elitch's was bought by Premier Parks who bought six flags in 2007 renaming it to "Elitch Gardens."


ALABAMA FOOTBALL CRIMSON TIDE


Learning More About Ms. Rodriguez One Goal At A Time.



Halloween Cake Pops

INGREDIENTS

1 package chocolate cake mix (regular size)

3/4 cup dulce de leche

to 8 lollipop sticks

2-1/2 pounds milk chocolate candy coating, coarsely chopped

Chopped cashews

DIRECTIONS

- Prepare and bake cake mix according to package directions, using a greased 13-in. x 9-in. baking pan. Cool completely on a wire rack.
- Crumble cake into a large bowl. Add dulce de leche and mix well. Shape into 1-in. balls. Place on baking sheets; insert sticks. Freeze for at least 2 hours or refrigerate for at least 3 hours or until cake balls are firm.
- 3. In a microwave, melt candy coating. Dip each cake ball in coating; allow excess to drip off. Coat with cashews. Insert cake pops into a styrofoam block to stand. Let stand until set. Yield: 4 dozen.



Now the kickoff and let's see who's got the ball now? Why it's Eddie Gracey! He's running it but oh my goodness!!! He is tackled hard!


